



BBA-LLB

(Five Years Integrated Programme)

Introduction: The five-year integrated course in B.B.A. LLB aims to equip students with knowledge, skills and ethics in both business management and law. Students will gain an understanding of core business concepts such as accounting, finance, marketing, and human resources, as well as their legal implications. Over the course of their studies, students will develop a strong foundation in the Indian legal system, relevant laws and regulations, as well as effective communication and research skills. The program consists of foundation and elective courses in business administration and law. Each student is required to complete a mandatory internship for a minimum of Twenty weeks throughout the course. The internship must be at a law firm or business organization and the student must prepare a report of their internship experience.

Course Structure: The B.B.A. LLB integrated course is organized into ten semesters.

Career Prospects

The B.B.A. LLB integrated course prepares students for a wide range of career opportunities in both business and law. Graduates can pursue careers in law firms, corporate legal departments, business consulting firms or government agencies. Students may also consider pursuing higher education in law or business, leading to a Master's degree in law or business administration.

Admission Process and Eligibility Criteria for B.B.A-LL.B Programme

The admission process for the B.B.A. LLB integrated course generally involves the following: - Successful completion of 10+2 exams with a minimum of 45% General Category; 42% Marks- OBC; SC/ST- 40% aggregate marks. - Entrance Exam MGMU- CET (CLAT or equivalent): The B.B.A. LLB integrated course provides students with a comprehensive understanding of both business administration and law. Upon completion of the program, students will be well equipped to pursue a successful career in either field. The program provides ample opportunities for experiential learning through internships, research projects and case studies.

LL.B. (3 - year Programme)

The three-year LL.B. degree is a postgraduate course that aims to provide comprehensive knowledge and training in law. The program is designed to equip students with necessary legal knowledge and practical skills to work as legal professionals. The course curriculum is structured to include subjects like Contract Law, Criminal Law, Constitutional Law, and other important laws and regulations, along with seminars and workshops on legal research and drafting, negotiation and dispute resolution.

The course structure is designed to be comprehensive, covering key areas of law and providing students with opportunities for hands-on learning. Two Year LL.M. Programme

LLM Two-year course with specializations in Criminal Law and Security, Intellectual Property Law, and Constitution and Administrative Law: Introduction: The two-year LLM course is a postgraduate program designed for graduates who wish to gain in-depth knowledge and understanding of law in specific areas of interest. This course offers students the opportunity to specialize in one of three areas: Criminal Law and Security, Intellectual Property Law, and Constitution and Administrative Law. Each specialization is designed to provide students with comprehensive knowledge and training in the respective fields of law. The course structure is designed to be comprehensive, covering key areas of law within the specialization chosen. Graduates of the LLM course with a specialization in Criminal Law and Security, Intellectual Property Law, or Constitution and Administrative Law are well equipped for a successful career in their chosen area of expertise.

Post Graduates of the LLM course with a specialization in Criminal Law and Security can pursue careers in legal fields related to regulatory and enforcement agencies, defence and prosecution, litigation, and consultation organizations. Graduates with a specialization in Intellectual Property Law can pursue careers as legal professionals in law firms, multinationals, electronic commerce enterprises, and research institutions. Graduates with a specialization in Constitution and Administrative Law can pursue careers in legal fields related to public interest organizations, non-profit organizations, and human rights institutions.



Admission Process

The admission process for the LLM course generally involves: - Successful completion of a bachelor's degree in law from a recognized University with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks. - Entrance Exam (CLAT or the entrance test administered by the respective college)

One Year P.G. Diploma Programmes

One-year diploma course of Taxation Law, Cyber Law and Security, and Labour Laws and Labour Welfare: **Introduction:** The one-year diploma course is designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the legal framework for taxation, cyber laws and security, and labour laws and welfare. The course is designed to equip students with knowledge and skills that will enable them to make a successful career in these fields. **Course Structure:** The diploma course is organized into two semesters, with a total of 12 credits per semester. The program consists of both foundation and elective courses in Taxation Law, Cyber Law and Security, and Labour Laws and Labour Welfare.
